Readers Learn Lessons


Reread the ending and think, "How did the trouble get fixed?"




What's the SAME?

The net of a 3D shape is what it looks like if it is opened out flat.


A net can be folded up to make a 3D shape.

There may be several possible nets for one 3D shape.


On the following pages are the nets of different shapes.

Cut them out and fold them into their 3D shapes. Tape them along the edges to secure the folding.


